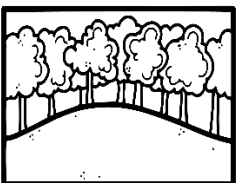

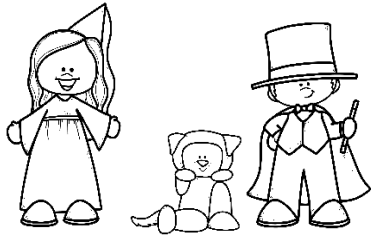

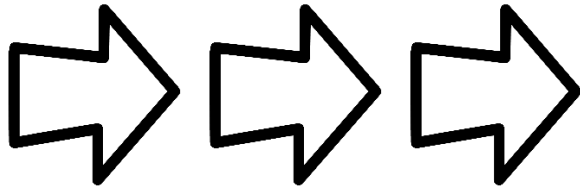

Directions for completing the Fiction Book Report form:

1. **Name** - Write the name you are called in class and your last name using correct punctuation.
2. **Date** - Write the month, day *and* year the report is due using correct punctuation.
3. **Title** - Write the title of the book making sure to underline the title and capitalize the appropriate words.
4. **Author** - Write the author's name using first name first, then middle name, and finally last name using correct capitalization.
5. **Number of pages** - List the number of pages in the book. If the pages are not numbered start with the first page of story text and count each page until the last page of story text.
6. The **setting** in a story is the *time* (year, season, month, or day/night) and *place* of the events in the story. There are incidences where the time of the events in a book are not explicit or only general such as "modern day".
7. List the main **characters** in the story *and* tell a little about their part in the story.
8. A **problem** in a story is something that goes wrong; something that needs to be fixed, changed or figured out. The **problem** in a story is often caused by the main character. Briefly explain the problem in the story using complete sentences.
9. The **plot** of a story is comprised of the attempts by the characters to resolve the problem. Briefly list each attempt without including the attempt that solves the problem called the resolution.

Books must be chosen from the required reading list or be approved in advance by your student's classroom teacher!

Successful completion of each book and form by the designated deadline will result in a test grade of 100%.

Late Work Policy

In 1st - 3rd grades, the student not turning in their Boni Libri report on time will be required to complete the assignment during recess period. If the student is not able to complete the late assignment during that time, the student will be required to complete the unfinished assignment at home and return it the next school day. If it is not returned completed the next school day, the student will continue to lose recess until the assignment is complete. No points will be deducted from their grade as a penalty for late work.
