FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What's the minimum age to attend Agathos?

Students must turn 4 years old by August 15th and be potty-trained to attend our PreK program, which serves a mixture of 4 and 5 year olds.

What are your class sizes?

PreK has two classes with a maximum of 12 students each. We target 15 students per class in grades K-12. Most grades have 2 classes.

How do I know if there are spots available in my child's grade?

Each fall, we have approximately 24 spots for Pre-Kindergarten. There are at least 6 spots available for Kindergarten students who did not attend PreK at Agathos. We expect spaces to be available for new students in most grades for the 2022-23 school year and anticipate wait pools in grades 1, 2, 5, & 11.

What is a wait pool?

We are grateful to God for drawing so many families that enrollment has doubled in the past 5 years! A wait pool is the group of students who have applied and been accepted pending available space in a grade. If you resonate with Agathos' mission and people, please submit an application, even if a spot isn't immediately available. We will be able to get to know you and your family better through the application process. When spots become available, they will be filled from the pool of applicants in the wait pool.

What grades currently have wait pools?

For the 2022-2023 school year, we anticipate wait pools for grades 1, 2, 5, & 11.

What are the admission deadlines & timeline?

We consider new student applications on a rolling basis. After current families have the first opportunity to re-enroll, available spots are offered to new students in February. Thereafter, students are accepted to classes or wait pools as application files are completed (online application, fee, character reference, parent interview, and student assessment.) Applications to enroll at the beginning of 2nd semester must be submitted by Dec 1.
